AEROBIC SEPTIC SYSTEM

The property located at _____ will have an aerobic septic system. Since this will be an aerobic system I understand that I do not have to furnish Rural Water District No. 2 with a copy of a PERC test.

However, I realize that a final inspection must be performed by Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on my aerobic system and a copy of approved final inspection of said system must be provided to the Water District.

The Rural Water District No. 2 Policy concerning sewage disposal systems:

- A. Not more than ninety (90) days after the installation of temporary set, a copy of approved final inspection, by DEQ, on aerobic septic system, must be received by the Water District office.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in the discontinuance of water service until such time as this report is received in the District #2 office.

Any meter installation where, by state law, a sewage system is not required (example: stock watering) will be considered exempt from the above policy until such time as the intended use of the installation changes.
